# Strike action on 30 June

## What can you do?

**Before  
30 June:**

- Talk to colleagues at your workplace, friends and relatives, tell them why you support the strike.
- If you can, hold a union meeting at your workplace, discuss support, collect money for union hardship funds
- Write to your MP, ask them to support our campaign
- Contact your union, ask them what they are doing to fight the cuts and when they intend to ballot for strike action

**On 30  
June:**

- Visit our picket lines. There will be pickets at schools and colleges, as well as Catford & Forest Hill jobcentres, Lewisham Police Station and Greenwich Magistrate's Court
- Join our march and rally in Central London
- Hold a meeting at your workplace
